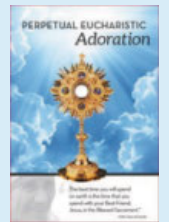

25th Anniversary of the Divine Mercy Adoration Chapel – January 1, 2025

Jesus, I trust in you!

With the words of Sister Faustina, *Jesus, I trust in you* fixed on their hearts, Father Robert Roll, then Pastor of the Church, and Father Stephen Lesniewski, then Associate Pastor, began a project to design and build an Adoration Chapel in the little corner of 38th and Paulina. Previously, the little corner of 38th and Paulina was a storage and ushers' room for the Church. Father Roll and Father Lesniewski took on the transformation and sought the expertise of George Allen Construction Company to build the Adoration Chapel. The Chapel was dedicated to the Divine Mercy of Jesus. The dedication of the Divine Mercy Perpetual Adoration Chapel took place on January 1, 2000. The Chapel was recognized by the reigning Pope John Paul II (now St. Pope John Paul II), with an apostolic blessing.

The many furnishings of the chapel came from various sources: closed parishes, convents, and other institutions. The pride of the chapel is the stained-glass windows in the doors of the chapel. These were the original windows in St. George Church in Bridgeport which closed in the early 1990's. The hanging sanctuary lamp came from a closed Christian Brothers' house in Indiana. The original altar was built in 1916 and stood as an altar shrine in a closed convent. The original monstrance and tabernacle came from closed parishes as well. The original pews were obtained from the convent at St. Isidore Parish in Blue Island, Illinois, where the Felician Sisters had served until 1999.

The image of the Divine Mercy is based on a vision received in 1931 by Sister Maria Faustina, a young Polish nun. In the vision, Sister Faustina saw Jesus clothed in a white garment with his right hand raised in blessing. His left hand was touching his garment in the area of the heart, from where 2 rays came forth: one red and the other pale. The rays represent the blood and water that flowed from Jesus' side when He was pierced on the cross. Jesus told Faustina to spread this image to all people with the words *Jesus, I trust in you! Faustina who was canonized a saint in 2000 by then Pope John Paul II, spread the image of God's mercy until her death from tuberculosis on October 5, 1938.*

In the past 25 years, over 300,000 people have sought the mercy of the Lord in our Divine Mercy Chapel. The chapel is there for everyone to pray, recite the rosary or chaplet, read the Bible, and adore Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. The Divine Mercy Chapel is a treasure. You need a code to get into the chapel. That code can be obtained from the parish office. Also, people are needed to sign up for an hour visit in front of the Blessed Sacrament in the chapel. Contact Josefina Hernandez or call the office.

With the words, *Jesus, I trust in you* the chapel was built. *A simple prayer that you might begin to say repeatedly, until it takes root in your heart. Once the words become a part of you, you may experience their power in your own life. How will these words affect your life? You may not build a chapel, but you can do greater things, like find the peace of the Lord in your life, bring others back to the church through your prayers, or build a personal relationship with Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament. You have nothing to lose but possibly eternal life to gain! Jesus is there waiting for you and me. Please, come to pay him a visit and taste the delights of his Merciful love.*

25° Aniversario de la Capilla de Adoración a la Divina Misericordia – 1 de enero de 2025

Jesús, en ti confío!

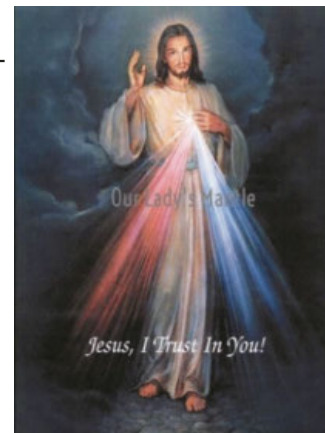
Con las palabras de la Hermana Faustina, Jesús, en ti confío fijadas en sus corazones, el Padre Robert Roll, entonces Pastor de la Iglesia, y el Padre Stephen Lesniewski, entonces Pastor Asociado, comenzaron un proyecto para diseñar y construir una Capilla de Adoración en la pequeña esquina de la calle 38 y Paulina. Anteriormente, la pequeña esquina de la calle 38 y Paulina era un almacén y una sala de acomodadores para la Iglesia. El Padre Roll y el Padre Lesniewski asumieron la transformación y buscaron la experiencia de George Allen Construction Company para construir la Capilla de Adoración. La Capilla estaba dedicada a la Divina Misericordia de Jesús. La dedicación de la Capilla de Adoración Perpetua de la Divina Misericordia tuvo lugar el 1 de enero de 2000. La Capilla fue reconocida por el Papa reinante Juan Pablo II (ahora San Juan Pablo II), con una bendición apostólica.

Los numerosos muebles de la capilla procedían de diversas fuentes: parroquias cerradas, conventos y otras instituciones. El orgullo de la capilla son las vidrieras de las puertas de la capilla. Estas eran las ventanas originales de la iglesia de San Jorge en Bridgeport, que cerró a principios de los años 1990. La lámpara colgante del santuario procedía de una casa cerrada de los Hermanos Cristianos en Indiana. El altar original se construyó en 1916 y se mantuvo como santuario en un convento cerrado. La custodia y el tabernáculo originales también procedían de parroquias cerradas. Los bancos originales se obtuvieron del convento de la parroquia de San Isidoro en Blue Island, Illinois, donde las Hermanas Felicianas habían servido hasta 1999.






La imagen de la Divina Misericordia se basa en una visión recibida en 1931 por la Hermana María Faustina, una joven monja polaca. En la visión, la Hermana Faustina vio a Jesús vestido con una túnica blanca con su mano derecha levantada en señal de bendición. Su mano izquierda tocaba su túnica en la zona del corazón, de donde salían 2 rayos: uno rojo y el otro pálido. Los rayos representan la sangre y el agua que brotó del costado de Jesús cuando fue traspasado en la cruz. Jesús le dijo a Faustina que difundiera esta imagen a todas las personas con las palabras *Jesús, en ti confío. Faustina, que fue canonizada santa en 2000 por el entonces Papa Juan Pablo II, difundió la imagen de la misericordia de Dios hasta su muerte por tuberculosis el 5 de octubre de 1938.*

En los últimos 25 años, más de 300.000 personas han buscado la misericordia del Señor en nuestra Capilla de la Divina Misericordia. La capilla está allí para que todos recen, reciten el rosario o la coronilla, lean la Biblia y adoren a Jesús en el Santísimo Sacramento. La Capilla de la Divina Misericordia es un tesoro. Necesita un código para entrar a la capilla. Ese código se puede obtener en la oficina parroquial. Además, es necesario que las personas se registren para una visita de una hora frente al Santísimo Sacramento en la capilla. Comuníquese con Josefina Hernández o llame a la oficina.

Con las palabras, *Jesús, en ti confío*, se construyó la capilla. *Una oración sencilla que puedes comenzar a decir repetidamente, hasta que eche raíces en tu corazón. Una vez que las palabras se vuelvan parte de ti, podrás experimentar su poder en tu propia vida. ¿Cómo afectarán estas palabras tu vida? Puede que no construyas una capilla, pero puedes hacer cosas más grandes, como encontrar la paz del Señor en tu vida, traer a otros de regreso a la iglesia a través de tus oraciones o construir una relación personal con Jesús en el Santísimo Sacramento. ¡No tienes nada que perder, excepto posiblemente la vida eterna que ganar! Jesús está allí esperándote a ti y a mí. Por favor, ven a visitarlo y prueba las delicias de su amor misericordioso.*

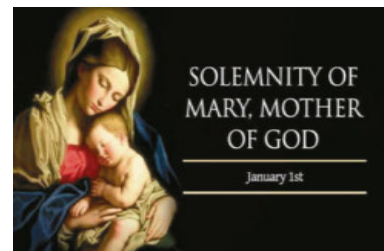
Bendición para los Adoradores de la Capilla de Adoración

Pro-Life Update January 2025

In several of our parish bulletins we have discussed the important work done by Crisis Pregnancy Centers (CPCs) and the legal challenges brought against them by pro-abortion governments. See the Pro-life Updates for August, September, and December 2023. These organizations provide free services such as pregnancy tests, ultrasounds and baby clothes, diapers, and baby formula to assist and encourage pregnant women and girls to choose life for their babies. In Illinois two lawsuits have been filed by such CPCs attacking the constitutionality of statutes which handicap their religiously motivated mission of counseling pregnant patients to choose not to have an abortion. One such suit, National Institute of Family and Life Advocates (NIFLA) v. Raoul, was successful in obtaining a court order preventing enforcement of a statute imposing fines on CPCs if they engaged in certain purportedly “deceptive practices.” See December 2023 Pro-Life Update. A second suit, also brought by NIFLA and others, seeks to invalidate an Illinois law requiring doctors and other employees of CPCs to inform pregnant patients of “all legal treatment options” and the “risks and benefits” of such options including abortion and contraception even if such advice would violate the CPC employees’ sincerely held religious beliefs. The case was tried before a judge and briefs were submitted to the court over one year ago. No ruling has yet been issued and presently there is no indication when a decision will be rendered.

Other states and pro-abortion public officials have actively sought to defeat the pro-life mission of CPCs. California enacted a statute in 2018 the Reproductive Freedom Act, to regulate pro-life centers that offered pregnancy related services. The Act required licensed clinics to inform pregnant women that the state provided free or low-cost services including abortions. The law also required unlicensed clinics to inform women that they were not licensed by the State of California to provide medical services. Several CPCs sued challenging the law on the basis that it abridged freedom of speech protected by the First Amendment. The case went up to the United States Supreme Court which agreed with the CPCs that the statute was unconstitutional.

Earlier this year the governor of Massachusetts began a \$1 million advertising campaign created by the state Department of Public Health which urged Massachusetts residents to avoid crisis CPCs because they spread “misinformation” about abortion and criticized the centers because they refused to make referrals to abortion providers. In April, 2024 the State of New York formally threatened litigation against ten pro-life CPCs for alleged “misleading statements and omissions in the advertising of the Abortion Pill Reversal (“APR”) protocol.” This threat relates to the centers’ efforts to assist women who have taken the first pill (mifepristone) of the two-pill prescription for a medication abortion and then later had misgivings. (See our August 2024 Pro-Life Update for an explanation of how mifepristone works in conjunction with a second drug, misoprostol, to complete a medication abortion). The effect of taking the first pill can be reversed if the pregnant woman changes her mind after taking the first pill and then is treated with supplemental doses of progesterone. When the centers received notice of intended litigation from the State of New York they filed suit against the Attorney General of New York seeking an injunction halting the state’s suit. The pregnancy centers are represented by the Thomas More Society, a public interest law firm based in Chicago active in many lawsuits on behalf of pro-life persons and organizations. See HEARTBEAT INTERNATIONAL Inc. et. al. v. LITITIA JAMES, Supreme Court of New York, Monroe County. The litigation is still pending.

Please pray for Crisis Pregnancy Centers. They do important pro-life work. They are under attack from well-funded, pro-abortion sources. Our parish is familiar with one of them, the Women’s Centers of Greater Chicagoland, through their annual Baby Bottle Project. Please join us for our next monthly Pro-Life Mass and Rosary on the first Saturday of the new year, January 4, 2025, at 8AM.

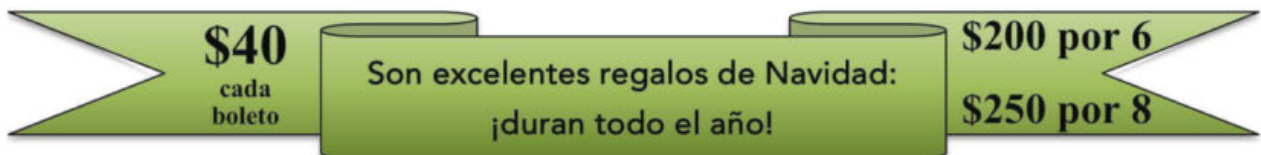
